Description of Property and Eligibility Determination *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Built in 1932, this structure is contemporary with the construction of MD 210 and corresponds with the intensified suburbanization of the study area related to the expansion of federal offices and military installations in the county. At this time, many farm owners sold larger parcels to residential developers to accommodate the growing local population. Atypical square, frame structure, this bungalow has a side gables roof with front and rear gable dormers, overhanging eaves with exposed rafter ends, six over one windows, and a large, open front porch with flared brick supports resting on textured concrete block bases. Sheathed in asbestos siding, the house has a square bay on the south side and an enclosed porch in the rear.

Research has not revealed any association between this structure and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in the past (Criterion B). The building is not a good example of any style; nor is it distinguished; it does not represent the work of a master or display high artistic merit (Criterion C). Although archeology was not addressed in this study, there is no indication


