Description of Property and Eligibility Determination *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Constructed circa 1940, this structure was built in association with the strawberry farm at 9410 Old Palmer road, likely in response to intensified suburbanization of the study area following the construction of MD 210 and related to the expansion of federal offices and military installations in the county. At this time, many farm owners sold larger parcels to residential developers to accommodate the growing local population. This L-plan, one-story brick house has a side gabled roof with an intersecting front gable section with cornice returns and an interior front porch supported by brick and wood post supports. The house is distinguished by an exterior chimney, one over one windows, and stretcher course sheathing extending from ground to roof.


Research has not revealed any association between this structure and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in the past (Criterion B). The building is not a good example of any style; nor is it distinguished; it does not represent the work of a master or display high artistic merit (Criterion C). Although archeology was not addressed in this study, there is no indication


that the property is likely to yield information important in history or pre-history (Criterion D). Therefore, this property is not eligible for the National Register.
