


William Morris and emphasized an open plan appropriate for "modern" living.

Research has not revealed any association between this structure and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in the past (Criterion B). The building is a fair but undistinguished example of the bungalow style, but suffers deterioration due to abandonment. It does not represent the work of a master or display high artistic merit (Criterion C). Although archeology was not addressed in this study, there is no indication that the property is likely to yield information important in history or prehistory (Criterion D). Therefore, this property is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.
