Building #01364 is a storage shed that was built in 1946 as part of the complex of the Visiting Officers' Quarters (VOQ), the single largest building type at Andrews Air Force Base. It is located on the west side of the base adjacent to the clusters of VOQs.

The building is a short, one-story tall, square structure built of concrete block. The original awning windows on one side of the building remain. The opposite side of the building has a sliding, glass double door set into a gable end addition. The hip roof on the building is covered with asphalt shingles.

This storage shed was constructed as part of the Visiting Officer's Quarters to provide storage for minor site maintenance equipment. The design integrity of the building has been damaged through the addition of a short wing on one side, topped with a gable roof.



