#3543 is a small, rectangular, one-story tall, brick structure constructed ca. 1925. The structure was originally built as a garage. It has a sloped shed roof, and one arched, double-hung wood window on each side, and sliding wood doors.

This building was originally constructed as a garage. Currently, it is a free-standing storage shed. Changes over the years have included the installation of a new roof, showing a short Mansart roof at the front, and a shed roof on the sides and rear. The property retains the original sliding garage doors and single side window.

Because the building predates construction of the base, it has no historic or architectural link to the facility. Within the historic context of use of the site as large estates and later, truck farms, prior to development of the airfield, it does not represent a significant or contributing element. In addition, due to the initial demolition associated with airfield construction, the physical context of the property has been destroyed with the removal of similar buildings and the introduction of military construction.




QUICK REACTION GRID MAP DEC 1970, ANDREWS AFB
