Modifications to the structure include the addition of a stucco finish on the head building, a lean-to addition to the north side, new garage doors, and new exterior lighting. With the exception of two trees, there are no landscaping plantings around the building.

This building was constructed to support the flight line at the base. It is located adjacent to hangers on the east side of the installation. Originally constructed out of exposed concrete block, the front portion of the structure (the Headhouse) has been covered with stucco, changing the character of the building through covering the block pattern and texture. In addition, the original garage doors, metal windows, and equipment have been removed. The setting of the structure has changed through the introduction of new hangers and other contemporary buildings adjacent to the site. The integrity of the structure has been damaged significantly through changes in the building entrances, roof, doors, the additions made to either side of the building.
