Building #3716 is a small one-story tall, concrete block structure built in 1943. It is three bays wide on the front, and slightly raised above the grade. The center door is flanked by two, six-over-six, double-hung wood windows. The building has a shingled, gable roof. Modifications to the building include removal of interior partitioning to accommodate its new use, installation of a new roof, and covering the exterior walls with aluminum siding.

The original use of Building #03716 is obscure. It is a small concrete block structure which was covered with aluminum siding sometime between 1958 and 1961. The property is located adjacent to Chapel II and its cemetery. Changes that have occurred to the building, besides the addition of siding, include a new roof, new interior partitions, and new entry.
