The building additions have a variety of windows, including multi-paned, double-hung wood, fixed glass, and jalousie. The roofs are high-pitched gable, covered with asphalt shingles. The main house has two roof dormers on the front, and has been raised in the rear. The raised section of the roof is covered with aluminum siding. The plan of the building has been changed to accommodate additional living space, bedrooms, and toilets.

This building was a small residential unit prior to acquisition by the government. It was of a Neo-Colonial design used extensively in the early part of the 20th century. The original fabric of Building #04002 has been modified significantly with additions to either side, the use of materials inconsistent with the original fabric, and the replacement of windows and doors. The setting of the building has also been modified through the removal of buildings contemporary with the structure, and the introduction of military buildings and activities. This has isolated the building and destroyed its original setting and the character of its environment.
