Building #04441 is a large one-story tall, rectangular concrete block structure located on the west side of the base. The main entrance to the building is centered on one side. All of the windows in the building have been blocked up. The roof is a gable design, covered with asphalt shingles. The entire building is covered with plywood sheathing with a vertical pattern.

When constructed as part of the second construction period at the base, Building #04441 appeared as a long concrete block building with steel frame windows. Since its construction the structure has been converted to a storage facility supporting the golf courses on the base. The structure has received a new roof, the original window and door openings have been blocked up, and the exterior has been covered with vertical wood siding.


