This concrete block, flat roofed structure is located on the east side of the base in a small cluster of maintenance buildings adjacent to Pennsylvania Avenue. The building is two bays wide. The structure has large garage doors at either end. The structure has been upgraded and added to numerous times as part of its use.

Building #3342 was constructed as a vehicle maintenance facility to support base operations. Its tall bays allowed it to be used for larger trucks and maintenance equipment. The integrity of the structure has been damaged significantly through changes in the building entrances, roof, doors, the additions made to either side of the building.


