Justification for decision: (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map)

Located on the east side of Pennsylvania Avenue at Andrews Air Force Base (AFB), this modest one-story tall frame dwelling dates from approximately 1920. A typical small house of the period, the building provided four bedrooms and a bath. Resting on a concrete foundation, the building is detailed by a gabled roof, front gabled dormer, one story porch and paired windows. Interior modifications have allowed the building to be used as office space by military personnel. This property was a component of the land purchased by the Army in 1942 to create the Camp Springs Airfield, the forerunner of Andrews AFB. Based on a reconnaissance survey, the Air Force determined that the building did not possess architectural significance, nor was its association with Air Force Base significant to be eligible as an individual resource. No historic district exists in this area of the base. The Trust concurred that the building was not eligible for the National Register.



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
