DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is an old tobacco barn, located at the end of a dirt road that goes past the house. This is one of the few remaining, old hewn-timber barns in the area. The vertical siding is weathered pine, and there are several window-like, louvered vents in the side of the building. The large, central barn doors are hung on old hand-wrought hinges.
