Description of Property and Eligibility Determination *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Constructed circa 1940, this structure was built in response to intensified suburbanization of the study area following the construction of MD 210 and related to the expansion of feral offices and military installations in the county. This side gables, one and a half story house has roughly symmetrical front projections at each end of the building, flanking a large casement picture window. Clad in aluminum siding, the house reflects a number of modifications including the addition of one or both projections and alteration and addition of fenestration. It sits on a concrete block foundation.

Research has not revealed any association between this structure and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in the past (Criterion B). The building is not a good example of any style; nor is it distinguished; it does not represent the work of a master or display high artistic merit (Criterion C). Although archeology was not addressed in this study, there is no indication that the property is likely to yield information important in history or pre-history (Criterion D). Therefore, this




