Description of Property and Eligibility Determination (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)

Description:
The residence at 520 Kerby Hill Road consists of a 1 1/2-story, frame construction, side-gabled structure. The buildings offers a symmetrical appearance, with the exception of a side room-size addition and lower grade garage. Construction materials include wood clapboard siding, a concrete foundation, 6/6 windows, 6/6 windows flanking a single-pane fixed unit, and asphalt roof shingles. The steep pitched roof has a central brick chimney and two gable, window dormers. A flat roof pediment projects over the centered, main entry. The only decoration consist of dentil molding along the side gable eave.

National Register Evaluation:
Research has not revealed any association between this structure and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in the past (Criterion B). The building is not a good example of any style; nor is it distinguished; it does not represent the work of a master or



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
