Description of Property and Eligibility Determination *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*


Constructed in 1939, this structures was built in response to intensified suburbanization of the study area following the construction of MD 210 and related to the expansion of federal offices and military installations in the county. This side-gabled, two story house has a pedimented front porch and an overhanging second story. A substantial garage has been constructed with a hyphen connecting to the main house, and evidence of substantial expansion is apparent in additions on the south and west elevations of the structure. Although the original lines of the house are obscured by vinyl siding, it seem likely to have begun as a one-story side-gabled cottage.

Research has not revealed any association between this structure and events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history (Criterion A) or the lives of persons significant in the past (Criterion B). The building is not a good example of any style; nor is it distinguished; it does not represent the work of a master or display high artistic merit (Criterion C). Although archeology was not addressed in this study, there is no indication that the property is likely to yield information important in history or pre-history (Criterion D). Therefore, this


