Located southeast of Indian Head Highway (Rt. 210) and extending to the Mattawoman Creek, the proposed subdivision includes remains of an agricultural complex, known as the Black property. The dwelling was destroyed by fire, leaving only the foundation wall. The property includes other foundations, makeshift shed, pump house, brick barbecue and a frame barn. The barn and pump house are the only historic buildings left standing on the property. The integrity of each is poor, as they exhibit signs of abandonment and deterioration. The barn has lost some of its siding and is overrun with vegetation. The property does not retain enough components of the historic period. Its lack of integrity excludes its eligibility for the National Register.








