DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a smaller 2-story frame house w/ some nice Victorian features. The main (south) facade has 3 bays, w/ a central door and a small center gable in the roof. However, there is no middle window on the upper level. A one-story open porch spans the front and part of the west end. The porch has turned, bracketed posts and spindles. The center and end gables are covered w/ patterned shingles, and have jig saw brackets in the apex. The central stove-chimney has a decorative cap and drip course Siding is clapboard. A lower, shed-roof wing, of similar style, is attached to the rear. Windows have 6/6 sash.


