DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a frame, Federal-style house, built in 2 sections. The main section is a 2-story, sawn-frame structure of 3 bays that faces south. The door is in the west end-bay. There is a steep A roof, now covered w/tin, and a nice molded cornice. The brick double-end chimneys have been removed from the east end wall, so there are two tall openings here now. Attached to the west end, is a small, one-story log kitchen wing. The logs are cut w/ dovetail notches. Both sections are covered w/the original old weathered pine siding. The house is being dismantled by the owners for other restoration projects. An old double tobacco barn sits nearby, in a field to the south.




