Description:

Pheasant's Thicket was previously surveyed by the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) in 1969. The property was described in the survey form as ruins, and is listed in the M-NCPPC files as having been destroyed in the late 1970s.

National Register Evaluation:

Pheasant's Thicket was not located during the September 1996 survey and is listed in the M-NCPPC files as destroyed. The site of Pheasant's Thicket is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not eligible under Criterion A, as research conducted indicates no association with any historic events or trends significant in the development of national, state or local history. Historic research indicates that the property has no association with persons who have made specific contributions to history, and therefore, it does not meet Criterion B. It is not eligible under Criterion C, as the structure is no longer extant and the site does not possess sufficient integrity to represent an important architectural trend or distinctive characteristics of a type or method of construction. Based upon the date of construction and the property type, there is a likelihood that an archaeological component could exist on the property. However, as no archaeological investigation has been conducted, the eligibility of the property under Criterion D cannot be assessed at this time.



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house is a 1-1/2 story, frame structure in ruined condition. In plan, it has four rooms with a staircase rising between the two east rooms. At the west end are double external chimneys with a frame pent between. Notable features that indicate an early date for parts of the house include beaded second floor joists that were originally exposed, with plastered walls extending to the floor boards between the joists, the framing of the principal and secondary posts to the plate and sill, and the roof framing, with mortise, tenon, and pegged rafters and half-lapped, half-dovetailed collars.




