DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a ruinous, small, tenant-type of dwelling that sits on a wooded knoll, NE of Baden-Naylor and Baden-Westwood Rds. It apparently was a small, one-story log house, with hewn logs covered with weatherboards. Only the roof remains today, and this was of hewn framing, with rough pine sheathing on the gable-ends, and an old, wood shingle roof. A braced-frame wing, or shed of some sort, is joined to the south end of the main building.






NOTTINGHAM DIST.

The Figures along the Roads, represent the Distance in Rods from junction to junction thereof.


