The Pirner house is a two-and-one-half-story frame gable - roofed house, five bays by two bays, which stands on the east side of Horsehead Road approximately one-fourth mile north of the Charles County line. Entrance is in the central bay of the west facade. There is a central pedimented crossgable at loft level. The Cornice is boxed with crown molding, and continues across the main facade, forming a pediment for the crossgable. Cornices are returned at the gable ends. Windows are 6/6 double hung sash and have brown louvered shutters. The horizontal board siding is painted beige. The roof is covered with asphalt shingle and the foundations are of concrete.

The Pirner house stands on part of the old Gibbons farm, but is not on the exact site of the former building, which was demolished circa 50 years ago.




