DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

There are 2 or 3 older farmhouses here on the north side of St. Philip's Road, just west of Rte. 381. Most of them are two-story, frame buildings of three bays with Victorian-era features such as pointed center gables, columned porches, stove-chimneys, and patterned tin roofs. Some are now tenant-occupied, and have added features such as asbestos-shingle siding, etc.






WOODVILLE AQUASCO P.O.


