

ACQUIRED BY RICHARD BENNETT 1706,
ONE OF THE LARGEST LAND OWNERS IN
MARYLAND. HIS DESCENDANT JUDGE
RICHARD BENNETT CARMICHAEL BUILT
THE HOUSE ABOUT 1805. HE PRESIDED
OVER THE CONVENTION OF 1867, FOR
A NEW CONSTITUTION FOR THE STATE
OF MARYLAND.
