DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Dundee is located on the north side of U. S. Route 50/301, on the northeast shore of Kent Island. The house and farm overlook the mouth of Chester River and Eastern Neck Island to the north.

Dundee was a small, 1 1/2 story brick house, probably dating to the first half of the 18th century. Unfortunately, it has been completely gutted, enlarged, and renovated. The only thing that survives is the first story of the brick shell, which measures 17 feet wide and 33 feet long. The brickwork is completely concealed by stucco, and a frame second story and two story rear L has been added.

The front facade faces east, parallel to the river bank to the north. The door is located in the center bay flanked by one 6/6 window on each side. A plain water table stretches across the facade but does not turn the corner at each end.

On the north gable wall there is one 6/6 window in the east bay, and on the south gable

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The brick shell of an early house forms the core of the present dwelling at Dundee. This early building was 1 1/2 stories high, 17 feet wide and 33 feet long, with a three bay facade. It has been completely renovated, covered with stucco, and enlarged by several additions. Early floor joists reused in the modern second story attic are finished with unusual ogee-molded edges. This single surviving feature combined with the overall form of the original house suggests a possible date of construction of mid-18th century or earlier.
