

Needwood Farm and its Tenant House (MIHP #QA-353) are contributing elements of a late nineteenth century agricultural site which includes barns, other outbuildings, and the fields which surround the standing structures. The House is a 5-bay, 2-1/2-story center gable building with a side-gable roof which has hipped dormers in the front and rear, and 2 interior chimneys. The building has one rear extension and the front porch has been enclosed and the entire building is sheathed in asbestos shingles probably over weatherboard. The front drive is an alleé of large oak trees. The property appears to retain good integrity through the elements of location, design, setting, feeling and association. Furthermore, the Farm's integrity as a whole is also quite strong, thus enabling it to meet National Register Criterion A, as an example of nineteenth and twentieth century agricultural site, and Criterion C, as architectural examples from the same time period, with the period of significance dating from 1880 to 1930.


