DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Elliott Farm or "Sledmore" is a two part frame building consisting of a three bay 2 1/2 story frame structure with a three bay two story back wing.

The facade of the building has a plain hip roof porch across the three bays. Centered on the facade is a door. The walls of this section appear to have beaded siding. On the second story of the east facade are three windows with 6/6 sash. On the roof are three 'A' roof dormers, also with 6/6 sash.

The gables have small 4-pane casements flanking the chimneys. The first story brickwork of the chimneys is exposed to the 2nd floor level.

From the road, it appears that the back wing, with relatively flat 'A' roof was built in the second half of the 19th century. The house appears to have a hall-parlor plan, but that is only conjectural.

The Surveyor was not allowed on this property.


