DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame building is located on the west side of Broad Street in Crumpton, between Front Street and Second Street. It is three bays wide and two rooms deep, with a low-pitch hip roof and a one story open porch on the front facade. Directly adjoining the north wall of this building is a two story, three bay dwelling constructed of an unusual type of locally made concrete block.

A central entrance door with two-light transom on the front facade is flanked by tall, narrow 2/2 windows. Two broader 2/2 windows pierce the second story. Plain horizontal weatherboards cover the exterior; the corner boards are also plain. Large scrolled brackets support a box cornice with complex crown mold. The cornice returns at the south corner and butts against the adjoining building on the north.

The fenestration of the south wall is asymmetrical, with three 2/2 windows on the first floor and two on the second floor.

7.1 DESCRIPTION

The rear facade is almost entirely covered by two later shed roof additions.

The interior of the original building is divided into two rooms, one behind the other. Each room is heated by a separate chimney on the west or rear wall. A closed string stair with heavy turned newels and ballusters rises in the northeast corner of the back room. A door in the rear wall of this room leads to a later kitchen and utility room. Decorative details include a Victorian mantel in the front room and a variety of architrave moldings.

The second floor is also divided into two rooms, flanking the enclosed stair well. The windows on the west wall of the rear room have been cut down to small 1/1 sash to make room for the roof of the later addition.


