

In Frederic Emory's 1950 book, *Queen Anne's County, Maryland*, p. 429, the county's involvement in the War of 1812 is discussed. The following is in reference to 1813:

The proximity of the enemy imparted additional animation, no doubt, to the usual Fourth of July celebration, which was held this year on Monday, the 5th of July, by citizens of Centreville at "The Fort," which was doubtless the earthworks thrown up on the promontory of Corsica Creek, opposite Spencer's Wharf, remains of which were visible in recent years.
