DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Tanyard Farm is located on the Centreville-Queenstown Road just south of Tanyard Branch. The house is sited on a very narrow rise of land between the road and a pasture below. It is a low brown shingle vernacular dwelling which obviously grew as the farm family's needs grew. It is composed of three one story sections. The tallest section is nearly equal in length to the two other sections. It appears to be a 3 bay long structure with chimney within the north gable and one built on the outside of the south gable. Across the facade is a lean-to glazed porch, the roof of which begins at the bottom of the main roof. On the west side is a lean-to, but here the roof begins higher in the roof, below the double dormers. A smaller one story, one bay 'A' roof structure is built out the back. The south gable has two windows flanking the chimney on both stories, 6/6 sash on the first story and 1/1 sash on the second. There is also a lower window in the back lean-to.

The central section of the house has three 6/6 sash windows covering most of its wall. This section has a lean-to on both sides and sets back of

the face of the larger structure. By being so located, there is able to be a 6/6 sash window on the second story gable of the main part. There is a single 4-pane casement dormer on the roof.

The third part, set back farther still, is a basic one room structure with two small 6-pane sash windows and a central door. There is a small brick chimney in the north gable. Only two windows are located on the back of this section. The gable wall has two squarish 20th century windows flanking the chimney and a 4/2 sash in the gable.

A recent deck has been built behind parts of the center and main sections to take advantage of the height above the pasture.

In front of the kitchen wing is a brick-paved area to the old well. A gate and fence separates the service area with a modern swimming pool.


