The Church Hill Survey District is composed of 108 major resources lying along Main Street (Rt. 19), between Rt. 213 and the Church Hill-Sudlersville Road; along Walnut Street, east of Main Street; and along Church and Sterling Lanes. The majority of the resources are residential, with two churches and roughly half a dozen commercial structures. Of the 108 resources, 95 contribute to the potential district; 13 do not contribute. Although a period of significance has yet to be identified, the district's resources date primarily to the late-nineteenth century and the early-twentieth century. A small number of structures were built in the eighteenth or early-nineteenth centuries, most notably St. Luke's Episcopal church (QA-51), the Old Academy (QA- 52) and the Finch House (QA-138). A number of contributing commercial and residential structures date from the 1910's through 1950. There are only a handful of resources from the latter half of the twentieth century. Most of the contributing resources retain an extremely high level of integrity, despite the widespread use of vinyl and aluminum siding.
