Based on the available information and a site visit by MHT staff, 213 Front Street does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing. The modest frame gable roof house with single story front porch and rear ell was probably constructed around the turn of the century and is a common vernacular house type represented in large numbers throughout the state. It does not appear to have any particular architectural significance, nor is it known to have been associated with any significant events or people. There appears to be a National Register eligible historic district in Crumpton. However, this property lies outside the likely boundaries of such district.



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


