Based on the available information and a site visit by MHT staff, 248 Sassafras Street does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing. The modest frame gable roof house with single story front porch and rear ell was probably constructed around the turn of the century and is a common vernacular house type represented in large numbers throughout the state. It does not appear to have any particular architectural significance, nor is it known to have been associated with any significant events or people. In addition, the house has undergone substantial alterations, including various rear additions and the enclosure of the front porch, and lacks integrity. Based on the above referenced site visit, and despite an apparent concentration of inventoried properties, there does not appear to be a sufficiently cohesive grouping of resources to constitute an historic district in Millington. The house at 248 Sassafras Street is located at the extreme southern end of the town of Millington, well away from any concentration of historic properties.




