4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC **yes**

This is a very small house on a high basement. It is two bays wide and only one room deep. The door is on the right and there is an exterior brick chimney on the left. The windows are nine over six. There is a new one storey high, three bay wide addition which, on the right of the house, occupies the site of the old Kitchen and utilizes its fireplace. The foundation is so high that a steep flight of stairs runs up to the front door. The chimneys of this house are old but the exterior siding and interior walls and roof are all newly constructed, in keeping with the plans of the original building.

Nutter's Purchase is a lovely little cottage which is very well kept up. The Jeffries have restored it very well and have recently planted a boxwood garden to the front of the house. The site is near the Manokin Presbyterian Church and its cemetery.

To the rear of Nutter's Purchase is an interesting 200 year old out-building. Very small, with horizontal shiplap siding, its steep roof gives it a very medieval character. It has recently been moved to its present site from the Pusey Cemetery in East Princess Anne.


