Based on available information the structure at 3234 Boone Rd., Chrisfield, Md., does not meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing and is not located within a National Register Historic District. This two story, front gable, single bay Queen Anne style victorian house is typical of residential structures built from 1880 to 1900. The enclosure of the front porch and the addition of non-appropriate siding have compromised the historic integrity of the structure. It is not likely to be eligible under Criterion C. It is not known to have been associated with any significant event or person and is not located in an identified historic district.


