Located at the northeast intersection of County Wharf Road and Rt. 245, the existing one-story frame building has been vacant since its use as a restaurant in the late 1980s. The vernacular gabled-roof building, was built as a store in 1907 and has been used primarily for this purpose. Other functions include a school and restaurant. The building has been modified with modern materials such as asphalt shingle roof and plywood siding, particularly the interior with dropped ceilings, wallboard and HVAC systems. A bank of 6/6 replacement windows lines the north elevation. The building alterations have severely compromised the historic architectural integrity; it does not meet the NR criteria for listing.

The Smith Island Visitor's Center will be built on-site.


