The Rolley house, located at 8933 Old Princess Anne Rd, Princess Anne, Somerset County, MD is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Rolley House is a 1-1/2 story cottage-type house built circa 1930. The frame structure sits on a parged concrete foundation and is covered with a low gable roof with a center chimney. Two additions, on the north and south sides of the house are shed-roofed and enclosed. The windows have attached aluminum shades.

The dwelling is typical of the domestic architecture of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or A.


