Based on the information provided, 29812 Mt. Vernon Road does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for Evaluation. The frame, four-square type house was probably constructed in the early 20th century. It was an extremely common house type on the Eastern Shore and throughout the state in that period and numerous excellent examples remain. The house at 29812 Mt. Vernon Road appears to have been a very modest version of the type and has undergone numerous alterations. Thus it does not appear eligible under Criterion C. Moreover, it is not known to be associated with any significant event or person. Finally, it is located some distance from the town of Princess Anne and its historic district. It is not located in any other known historic district.




