Now in a ruinous state, this three-part frame structure evolved from the two-story central portion of circa 1810. About fifty years later, the house was enlarged by the addition of a parlor and two upstairs rooms on one end and a one-story kitchen on the other.

The original section has a one room and hall plan. The second floor remains almost unchanged in detailing, even to the paint. The single exterior chimney was rebuilt when the kitchen was added.
