Although this house has been extensively altered on both the interior and exterior, enough physical evidence remains to permit a fairly accurate reconstruction on paper of the exterior and the floor plan.

Of stone construction (common ironstone) with gable ends of brick, the house was three bays in length with centrally positioned doors on the side elevations. Today, the main facade is at the east end, and the house has a gambrel roof. The single chimney at the west end, stylistically an 18th century feature, may be a replacement or addition. It is also possible that two chimneys once stood at this end. All existing windows are in approximate original locations, but have been changed in width and possibly length. The center window of the south elevation was formerly a door, which is now filled in.

is a regionally significant house architecturally and warrants further architectural and historical research.

Although ^{extensively} ~~incredibly~~ altered and renovated on both the interior and exterior, ^{in the 1930s} enough physical evidence remains to do a fairly correct reconstruction of the exterior of the house and its interior plan on paper. Of ^{possibly} common iron stone ^{+ 2 windows deep} with gable ends of brick, the house was ^{possibly} three bays in length with centrally positioned doors on the side elevations. Today the main facade is at the E. end. The house has a gambrel roof (^{possibly} orig!) and a single chimney at the W. end. The chimney is of an eighteenth century date stylistically but may be a replacement or addition. It is also possible that there were two chimneys at this same elevation. All existing windows are in approximate original locations but have been changed in width and possibly length. The center window of the S. elevation was formerly a door, now filled in.
