Horse Range Farm is known to a great many Southern Marylanders as a place where jousting tournaments, the Maryland state sport with origins in the medieval European games, are still an annual event, hosted by the hospitable owners of the farm.

On the property is a rambling, two-story frame main house, as well as a mid-19th century, one-room schoolhouse, one of the earliest extant examples in Southern Maryland. It was recently rescued from certain destruction and attractively relocated and restored.

One-room schoolhouse formerly located on this property has been moved to the St. Clement's Island Museum where it is open to the public.

The double chimney at one end has a flush pent. The Floyd family built INDUSTRY\* about the year 1800. It has both the separate kitchen-curtain and brick pent motifs. The House across the road from "Industry" is on similar lines.



DEAR BOUGHT was built on 164 acres patented in 1790 by William Hilton. The house has twin chimneys and pent, a carry-over into the late Eighteenth Century of an early St. Mary's feature.



The OLD HOUSE ON BAY NEAR TRAP is an example of the type having a square plan in its main part, double chimneys at one end with one of the chimneys covered by a low kitchen wing. An OLD HOUSE NEXT "INDIAN BRIDGE HOUSE" is of this general character, also.
