CHICKAHOMINY

Chickahominy, a spacious house overlooking the Wicomico River, was built at the beginning of the 20th century at the direction of Mrs. Attaway Garner, then-owner of the property. Its nearly square, two-story main block is a mixture of Colonial Revival and late 19th century details. The principal facade is five bays in length at the first floor, with a bracketed cornice and a deep full-length farm porch. The hipped roof has *ten* pedimented dormer windows, and there are four chimneys positioned near the ridge. To one side of the house is a two-story wing.
