Bolton was moved from Waldorf, Charles County, Maryland, to a new site on Coombs Creek near Compton, St. Mary's County in 1976. On the exterior the house, *dating from circa 1830-1850*, represents the retention of a style of architecture more prevalent during the second half of the 18th century. Constructed over the foundations of a smaller house, some fabric from this earlier house was reused in Bolton.

Bolton is a 1 1/2-story house with pedimented dormer windows and two exterior chimneys at each end. A one-story, late 19th century addition at the west end incorporated an earlier wing in its plan. The first-floor plan of the main block consists of a center hall extending the depth of the house with two rooms on each side. Most of the interior detail is late Federal in style.





ORIGINAL ARCHTRAVES IN HALLWAY AND S.E. ROOM






SOUTH ELEVATION


CORNICE MOLDING ON NORTH ELEVATION (Not to scale)





ORIGINAL ARCHITRAVES IN HALLWAY AND S.E. ROOM




SOUTH ELEVATION






GROUND PLAN
