The sole source of evidence for a description of the Hodgdon House and associated outbuildings has been a survey report of all structures in the Patuxent River Naval Air Station area that was conducted upon the establishment of the facility in 1942. According to that document, the Hodgdon ~~XXXXX~~^{residence} was located approximately 20 feet above sea level on a level terrace less than 300 feet south of the Patuxent River, between what is now called Davis Road and the NAS West Basin. The house was a rambling $2\frac{1}{2}$ -story, 22-room frame dwelling, primarily square in plan with a steeply gabled, hipped roof and four interior corner chimneys, with a square $3\frac{1}{2}$ -story stair tower, 2-~~so~~^{ory} wing, and multiple doorways.

Included among a number of what appear to be early 20th-century farm out buildings is a $1\frac{1}{2}$ -story, four-room frame dwelling four bays long and one room deep with a single interior chimney and steeply pitched shingled gable roof. Wide wood siding covers the entire structure below the cornice. The principal facade has two doorways, positioned with two windows between, apparently serving a double family occupancy. The structure is very similar to other buildings in Southern Maryland that have been identified as 19th-century slave/tenant quarters -- most especially similar to the Brom-Howard slave quarter (18 Sm 33) in St. Mary's City.

The Hodgdon House appears to have been a large farm house with Italianate embellishments that probably dates to the early 20th century. The Quarter may well be mid-19th century in date,

and thus would represent a significant archaeological resource. Unfortunately, ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ the site of the Hodgdon Quarter has not been archaeologically verified; the general location of the Hodgdon House has been discovered.
