ST. GEORGE'S CATHOLIC CHURCH

Valley Lee

1851

The first church at Valley Lee was erected ^{in 1851} by William Coad, his brother George and his son Edwin, with the help of their slaves. During the period 1911-1919 the building was altered extensively and two wings were added to the nave, giving the church the shape of a cross. In 1959 St. George's was replaced by a new church situated slightly behind the old structure. The cemetery here dates from 1851.
