The isolated location of St. Inigoes, made the store a vital resource to the surrounding community. Stores such as this, provided area families with a wide array of supplies, food, and clothes. It was also a social center, where neighbors could not only shop, but also exchange news and pleasantries. Such enterprises are growing increasingly rare in the county as large box stores such as Walmart, Target, and Lowe's have flooded local markets with low cost alternatives.

Strategically positioned just north of the intersection of Trapp and Point Lookout Roads, the St. Inigoes General Store is located in the small crossroads community of St. Inigoes, Maryland. Oriented on an east/west axis, the store resides on a 0.6 acre lot that has been modified to fit its current use as a roadside commercial establishment and apartment building. A slender parking lot is situated to the west of the store and features two curb cuts that permit entrance and exits from Point Lookout Road. The property is bounded to the north and east by a residential subdivision, to the south by a commercial lot, and to the west by the road.

The store building, constructed c. 1920, is a two-and-a-half story, three bay, frame building that is often characterized by architectural surveys as a four-square – a building with an overall boxy appearance. Although the foundation is obscured, the exterior walls are sheathed with aluminum siding. The distinctive low-pitched pyramidal roof is covered with decorative pressed metal shingles. In addition to the main building is a one story, frame addition that extends from the east and south of the store.

The front or west elevation of the store has been dramatically altered to increase the amount of space within the building. To accommodate these needs, a shed roof extension was constructed. Laid up in an all stretcher brick bond, this extension features a central door flanked on either side with paired plate glass store windows. Just above these bays is a large sign that reads “St. Inigoes General Store, Open 7 days, Pizza Ice Cream Deli, On-Off Sales.” The second floor is pierced by three symmetrically placed, six-over-one, double-hung sash windows. The attic story is lit by a hip roof dormer pierced by two one-over-one windows.

The south elevation has also been modified in order to accommodate the second floor apartments. While the first floor is not fenestrated, the second floor is pierced by three six-over-one windows and a doorway. The doorway is accessed via a modern staircase and open porch. The roof is pierced by a hip roof dormer pierced by two one-over-one windows. The rear addition is visible here and is covered with aluminum siding. The hipped roof is sheathed with asphalt shingles.

No other elevations were observed.





DEPTH GRADIENTS


