21745 Whites Neck Road is a well preserved example of a pattern book bungalow from the early twentieth century. Constructed circa 1934, the one-and-a-half story, four bay, frame house is best distinguished by its four battered porch posts supported by formed concrete blocks, the double-pitch roof, and the exterior end chimney that climbs the house's south side. Aladdin as well as Sears, Roebuck, & Company pattern books should be combed to determine the house type's name and features. Further research should be conducted to find the original owners and see how much of the house's interior remains intact.

21745 Whites Neck Road is located on the west side of the road in the rural community of Bushwood, Maryland. Oriented on an east/west axis, the house lies on a flat two acre parcel characterized by a mowed yard, contributing storage barn, and flag pole. The property is bounded by a wooded parcel to the north, a dirt drive to the south, a wooded parcel to the west, and the road to the east.

The dwelling, constructed circa 1934, is a one-and-a-half story, four bay, frame bungalow with a double-pitch gable and a one story wing. The exterior of the house is sheathed with artificial siding while the roof is clad with asphalt shingles. An exterior end brick chimney climbs the south gable end of the house.

The primary or east elevation is dominated by a front porch supported by four battered posts that rest on concrete block bases. The spaces between two of the posts feature a balustrade of square balusters and a plain rail. Shaded by the porch, the first floor fenestration consists of a door and three closely spaced, six-over-one, double-hung sash windows. The half story is lit by two, six-over-one windows that pierce a centrally located gable roof dormer.

The south elevation exhibits the exterior end chimney as well as a hipped roof projection. While a small window lights the front room of the house from this side, the projection is and half story above are each fenestrated by paired six-over-one windows.

No other elevations were observed at the time of the visit.




