The property with the address Rt. 1 Box 295-C Mattapany Road (no house number) in Lexington Park, Maryland is located outside of the Saint Mary's City Historic District and is not considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The modest, one-story frame dwelling, constructed in the second quarter of the 20th century, lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


