Summary Description:

This small one-story, wood frame, lateral gable dwelling is rectangular in plan with a shed roof addition spanning the rear elevation. The facade contains a central entrance covered by a single bay shed roof to protect from the elements. The building is situated on the edge of a small corner lot with little or no setback off Division Street. The house has a concrete block foundation and is clad in aluminum siding.

This building is a one-story, wood frame, lateral gable dwelling constructed in the mid-twentieth century (ca. 1948). The building is situated on the corner of its lot with little or no setback, placing it very close to Division Street. A gravel drive provides parking on the south side of the house. The building is rectangular in plan with a shed roof addition spanning the length of the rear elevation. The facade contains a central entrance flanked by six-over-six-double hung windows. A single bay, shed roof protects the front entrance from the elements. Each end elevation contains two six-over-six, double-hung windows. A modern entry door on the south side of the house provides access to the rear addition. There is a single octagon shaped window and an exterior concrete block chimney on the rear elevation. The building rests on a concrete block foundation and is clad with aluminum siding. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles.


