DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The old house on the Eastern Shore Nurseries, east of Easton consists of an early 19th century Federal brick farmhouse with later frame wings and porches. The old building is basically a three bay two and one-half story structure with side entrances. Its southeast facade is laid in Flemish bond while the remainder of the house is common bond. The windows have 6/6 sash on both floors and in the attic dormers. There are jack arches above the windows and a chimney rises within the southwest gable. On the southwest is a small enclosed porch and on the northeast is a two story two bay wing added in 1929. A porch surrounds two sides and contains an enclosed area on the second story gable.






