Based on the available information, 422 Cherry Street does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing. The modest frame I-house may date to the latter part of the 19th century. A rather typical example of workers housing for the period, it does not appear to possess sufficient architectural significance to merit individual listing. In addition, it is not known to have been associated with any significant person or event. Lastly, it is not located in an historic district. The area, just to the north of the boundary for the Easton Historic District, was excluded from the district, presumably because the quality and/or concentration of the resources in this area was less than that within the district.




